



You are invited to participate in the **Four Winds program**

The Four Winds program instructs parent, like yourself, in how to foster children's curiosity about the world around them. Most of the teaching in this program is shared through hands-on nature activities. Students have a chance to learn science, math, reading and other subjects experientially.

Parent who volunteer receive free training on each topic, which is offered at two different times of the day - once in the morning and once in the evening. All activity supplies and materials are provided.

After the training, parents arrange a time with the teacher to bring the nature topic into their child's classroom. If the weather permits some activities are done outside. Students, teachers, and parents always end up learning something new - gaining a deeper appreciation and awareness when looking at the world.
